No idea what might cause this behavior. The only suggestion I have is to upgrade to version 2.2.10. This is a maintenance release with a number of bug fixes. Also, check the session log:

```
$HOME/.graphon/log/$USER-$DISPLAY-session.log
```

to see what error might exist. Last but not least, open a ticket with the support team.
