Goglobal session just need the port which you setting in Cluster Manager(default 491)

You can some hind drive that will increase drive open speed.

ex goglobal server had C,D,E .Client drive mapping will start at F,G,H....

So you can set registry hide H,I,J,K,.....and that will appear in F,G in goglobal session.That will be faster display all mapping drives.
