GO-Global Windows Host 4

With GO-Global Windows Host 4, users can access applications on Windows computers over LANs, WANs, VPNs and the Internet from most client devices. GO-Global Windows Host 4 is a major upgrade to GraphOn's "GO-Global for Windows" product. On the surface, it looks and feels much like GO-Global for Windows, but under the hood, it has many enhancements that improve performance, compatibility and quality. In addition, it comes with built-in support for the GO-Global Portal, which will provide GO-Global users with many new features and capabilities.

New Features & Functionality

- **64-bit OS Support**
 - The Host Edition supports both 64-bit and 32-bit applications running on the x64 versions of Windows Vista, Windows Server 2008 and Windows 7.
- **Portal-ready Architecture**
 - GO-Global Host Edition comes with built-in support for the GO-Global Portal which will soon be available as an add-on product. The GO-Global Portal will provide a secure, high-availability gateway to GO-Global Hosts and will include enterprise-level authentication, access control, and load balancing features.
- **Automatic Client Updates**
 - Administrators can now configure GO-Global to automatically update Windows Clients when users connect to a Host that is running a newer version.
- **Dynamic Display Resize**
 - GO-Global automatically adjusts the session's resolution when users reconnect to sessions from different computers or change the resolution of the client computer's display.
- **Performance Auto-Tuning**
 - A number of optimizations improve performance of animations and certain heavy graphics applications when used over slow connections. This setting is disabled by default.

- **Faster Application Startup**
 - Per-process CPU and memory usage overhead are greatly reduced. As a result, applications start more quickly and consume less memory.
- **Improved Application Compatibility**
 - GO-Global 4 has a simpler interface to the operating system that provides enhanced compatibility with both x86 and x64 applications.
- **Simplified Client Printing & Management**
 - Client printing has an updated, streamlined architecture with improved client compatibility, better integration with Windows hosts, faster session startup time, and support on 64-bit hosts.
- **Upgrade Wizard**
 - An automatic upgrade tool provided as part of the setup program eases the migration from version 3.2 to 4.0.
- **License**
 - A new license will be required to access 4.0 Hosts. Customers who are current with their Support Maintenance can request a license upgrade at: <http://www.graphon.com/customer-support/upgrade-form>.
- **Familiar User Interface**
 - GO-Global Windows Host 4 has a new look, but it works just like GO-Global for Windows Version 3. This allows for users to upgrade to Version 4 with little or no retraining.

New Terminology

- **Host:** GO-Global Servers are now referred to as “Hosts”. The Host provides multi-user remote access to applications and files.
- **Portal:** Centralized web application that provides a secure, high-availability gateway to GO-Global Hosts.
